

6. Conditions of obtaining a scholarship

The citizens of non-EU countries can be enrolled in Romania on their own expense, paying the tuition fees established by government decision or by obtaining scholarships offered by the Romanian state.

Scholarships awarded to foreign students:

- scholarships on reciprocity basis, in accordance with international cultural cooperation documents;
- scholarships through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, especially for young people coming from countries with which Romania has not perfected international cultural cooperation documents according to the external interests of Romania;
- scholarships through the Ministry of Economy, in order to promote economic and commercial cooperation actions;
- scholarships through the Ministry of Education, Research, Youth and Sport, for foreign citizens with good results obtained during their studies in Romania.
- scholarships offered by universities.

The amount and number of scholarships granted to citizens of other countries is determined by Government decision.

The scholars from non-EU countries benefit from free educational process, free accommodation in student houses, free Romanian health assistance and a monthly scholarship in the quantum established by Government decision.

The payment of scholarships is realized as follows:

- the scholarship is in RON;
- scholars, citizens of non-EU countries, benefit from scholarships only during their studies, the entire calendar year, including the holiday periods when they remain in Romania;
- scholarships are also awarded during the Romanian language preparatory year.

Scholarships are suspended in case of failure to promote a year of study, violation of the Romanian legislation or rules of conduct established by universities which brings about expulsion.

Scholarships are still awarded 30 days after the completion of doctoral or post-university studies.
